

Dearborn County Council Budget Adoption

Meeting Date: October 25, 2011

Members of the Dearborn County Council met in the County Administration Building, 215-B West High Street, 3rd Floor – Commissioners Room, Lawrenceburg, Indiana beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Present: Dennis Kraus, Sr., President, Bill Ullrich, Bryan Messmore, Maynard Barrett & Liz Morris, Council members and Leah Bailey sitting in for Gayle Pennington, Auditor

The council meeting started with the recitation of the *Pledge of Allegiance*.

Highway Department – Todd Listerman explained the he had received notification for reimbursable funding for three road slips.

Hogan Hill at a cost of \$125,000.00 and West Laughery at a cost of \$150,000.00. 75/25 approval from FEMA.

State Line at a cost of \$225,000.00 and reimbursed at 80/20.

Approval to approach Council on November 22, 2011.

Agree to fund, all ayes.

Sheriff – Mike Kreinhop asked for signatures on the Amendment for Dearborn County Police Retirement Plan.

Juvenile Detention Center – Request for four part time employees.

Treasurer – Barb Kaffenberger presented a salary upgrade for the Treasurer's deputies.

Council voted unanimously to table until the November 22 meeting.

Riverboat Savings Account – Dennis would like to table this discussion until the full board is in attendance.

All agreed to table until the November 22 meeting.
