Rental Registration & Inspection Program REGISTRATION OF RENTALS DUE JULY 31ST, 2017

Effective May 1st, 2017 owners of property containing multifamily rental housing <u>(TWO</u> <u>UNITS OR MORE)</u> must be registered with the City. Registration includes basic information about property, units, owner contact information, and a \$5 registration fee.

RENTAL REGISTRATION DUE JULY 31st, 2017

RENTAL REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION PROGRAM

Process:

1. All property owner(s) must complete a registration form and \$5 payment per property.

2. Inspection officer will provide written notice of inspection at least 72 hours in advance.

3. Owner(s) is responsible for \$125 inspection fee per property and \$25 per dwelling unit.

4. Inspection Certificate issued upon a satisfactory inspection.

5. Inspection Certificate valid for 5 years, subject to ordinance 2017-001, as set forth in sec. 99.004.
