**Highway-**Temporary Truck Ban on Salt Fork and Georgetown roads – Todd Listerman

State Road 1 will close on or after April 15 until November 22 at the intersection of Mount  
Pleasant Road. Through traffic will not be allowed north of Pribble or south of York Ridge.

Signs will be posted to ban through trucks over 40 feet on Salt Fork and Georgetown  
roads. Unofficial detour is Georgetown, Stateline and North Dearborn roads.
